Which station in Brussels?

Brussels Midi is the main station in Brussels - it's Brussels Midi in French, Brussels Zuid in Flemish, and Brussels South station in English, it's all the same place. Unless otherwise stated all trains leave from there, including Eurostar. Frequent local trains cross the city, linking Brussels Midi, Brussels Central and Brussels Nord. Brussels Central is 5 min walk from the famous Grande Place, but only frequent local trains stop there, although some international expresses also at Brussels Nord on their way to and from Brussels Midi.
